James.[1] It became the first chapter in the Fifty Shades series of novels that follows the deepening relationship between a graduate, Anast Asia Steele, and a young business magnate, Christian Grey. Fifty shades of Grey has seasoned the best-selling lists worldwide. It was translated into 52 languages and set a record in the UK as the best-selling pocket of all time. The critical reception of the book, however, tended to negative, with the quality of its prose generally seen as poor, while the portrait of BDSM was targeted for criticism from a variety of perspectives. The next day José, Kate and Ana arrive for the photo shoot at the Heathman Hotel, where Christian is staying. Christian asks Ana out for coffee and asks if she is dating anyone, specifically José. Ana says no one's coming back. During the conversation, Ana learns that Christian is also single, but says that he is not romantic. Ana is intrigued, but believes that she is not attractive enough for Christian. Later, Ana receives a package from Christians containing first edition copies of Tess of the D'Ubervilles, which stunned her. Later that night, Ana comes out drinking with her friends and/or the drunk Christian composition, which informs her that she is coming to take her because of her intoxicated state. Ana goes out to get some fresh air and José tries to kiss her, but it stoppedThe arrival of Christian. Ana goes out with Christian, but not before she finds out Kate has flirted with Christian's brother, Elliot. Later, Ana wakes up and finds herself in Christian's hotel room, where he scolds her for her care of herself. Christian then reveals that he would like to have sex with her. Ana has an appointment with Christian, during which he takes her to his apartment with his helicopter, Charlie Tango. [3] Meyer commented the series, saying "that is not really my kind, not my thing ... well, he's fine. Fantastic!" [4] This revised and extended version of the master of the universe was divided into three parts. The first, entitled Fifty Shades of Gray, was released as an e-book and a print on request Paperback in May 2011 by The Writers' Coffee Shop, a virtual editor based in Australia. [5] [6] The second volume, Fifty Shades Darker, was published in September 2011; And the third, Fifty Shades Freed, followed in January 2012. The Writers coffee shop had a limited marketing budget and relied in great part to the blogs of books for early advertising, but the sales of the novel were increased by Word recommendation -OF-MOUTH. Many other erotic works quickly became best-sellers after the success of fifty shades, while other popular works, such as Anne Rice's beauty trilogy, were resurfaced (this time without pseudonyms) to meet the highest demand. [14] On August 1, 2012, Amazon UK announced that it has sold more copies of fifty shades of gray than any individual book in the Harry Potter series, although worldwide the Harry Potter series has sold more than 450 million copies than 50 shades of Grey's Sales of 60 million copies. [15] The reception of fifty shades of Grey has surpassed the best-select lists all over the world, including those of the United Kingdom and the United States. [16] [17] The series had sold over 125 million copies worldwide by June 2015, [18], while by October 2017 it sold more than 150 million copies worldwide. [19] The series was translated into 52 languages, [20] and set a record in the UK as the best-selling pocket of all time. [21] Critical response he received mixed with negative reviews, since most critics noted the poor literary qualities of the work. Salman Rushdie said of the book: "I have never read anything so severely written that it was published. Maureen Dowd described the book in the New York Times as "as Bron'ta "privo di talent," and said it was "paint and unwritten." [23] Jesse Kornbluth of Huffington Post said: "As a reading experience, fifty shades... is a sad joke, puny of Plot." [25] Weekly entertainment writer Lisa Schwarzbaum gave the book a "B +" rating and praised it to be "In class alone." [26] [27] The Daily Telegraph observed that the book was "the definition of a page-Turner", noting that the book was "wonderful and intriguing". [28] A reviewer for the Ledger-Enquirer described the book as guilty of fun and escapism, and that "it also touches an aspect of female existence [female submission]. In December 2012 he won both the categories "Popular Fiction" and "Book of the Year" at the national book awards of the United Kingdom.[35] in the same month, publishers weekly appointed e. l. james «Publishing public of the Year», a decision whose criticism on the times and on the new york daily news was summarized by the christian science monitor. 36] Previously, in April 2012, when and. l. fifty james was inserted between the «100 most influential people in the World» -of the magazine Time.[37] richard lawson of the atlantic wire criticized his fan inclusion in the year following the publication of the novel in 2012, accidents requiring first-aid visits increased by more than 50% compared to 2010 (a year prior to the publication of the book); it is assumed that this is due to people who have no familiarity with the correct use of these toys and with the safe practice of slavery and other sexual fetishes "perversi" in an attempt to recreate what they had read.[41] Msgr. dennis schnurr, Archbishop of Cincinnati, said in a letter at the beginning of February 2015: «History is presented as a love story; However, the underlying theme is that slavery, domination and sadomasochism are normal and pleasant." The study found that almost every interaction between Ana and Christian was emotionally abusive of nature, including stalking, intimidation and isolation. The study group also observed pervasive sexual violence within the definition of the CDC, including the use of alcohol Christians to circumvent Ana's ability to consent, and that ANA exhibits classical signs of an abused woman, including a constant perceived threat, stressful management and stressful management. [45 ] [46] A second study was conducted in 2014 to examine the health of women who had read the series, compared to a control group that had never read any part of the novels. The results showed a correlation between reading at least the first book and presenting signs of a food disorder, having romantic partners who were emotionally abusive and/or engaged in stalking behavior, engaging in binge drinking in the last month and with 5 or more sexual partners before the 24 years. Authors could not conclude if women already experience these "problems" were attracted by the series, or if the series influenced these behaviors to occur after reading the reading creating the underlying context. [47] The main researcher of the study argues that books romanticize dangerous behavior and "perpetuate dangerous abuse standards". [52] The challengers also stated that the book was "wrongly written", and were worried "a group of teenagers will want to try [BDSM]." [53] In March 2012, the branches of the Public Library in Brevard County, Florida, removed copies of fifty shades of grey from their shelves, with an official statement that it did not meet the selection criteria for the library and and The reviews for the book had been poor. A representative for the library stated that it is due to the sexual content of the book and that other libraries had refused to buy copies for their branches. [54] Deborah Caldwell-Stone of the American Library Association commented that "if the only reason why it does not select a book is that it disapproves its content, but there is a question for this, there is a question if you are right. "[54] Brevard County's public libraries have later made their copies available for Their customers due to public demand. [55] In Macae ©, Brazil, the Judge Raphael Quearoz Campos ruled in January 2013 that bookstores throughout the city must remove the series entirely from their shelves or make sure the books are wrapped and placed by the reach of minors. [56] The judge said he had asked to do such an order after seeing children reading them, [57] based his decision on a law stating that "magazines and publications whose content is improper or inadequate for children and Teenagers can be sold only if sealed and with warnings regarding the "
